

TRUCK DRIVER – Roads & Bridges Department

Lackawanna County is seeking a Truck Driver for the Department of Roads & Bridges. This position reports directly to the Department Director and Department Foreman.

Key Responsibilities:

- Operates dump trucks to haul/deliver designated materials
- Plows and treats roads for winter maintenance & operates snow control equipment
- Performs street paving and maintenance of storm drains, ditches & manhole covers
- Performs manual labor duties, indoors and outdoors in various weather conditions
- Performs minor equipment repair and maintenance
- Assists with set-up/clean-up of job sites including weeds, trash and debris and performs custodial tasks as required and directed
- Completes daily reports, time sheets and other reports as needed & required
- Utilizes customer service skills to maintain effective relationships with co-workers, officials and the general public

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or GED required
- 1 year in construction related field or equivalent vocational training required
- Valid CDL Class A drivers license required with 3 years of clear driving record (or Class B with the ability to obtain Class A within 90 days of start date)
- Ability to properly operate a variety of equipment including hot mix machine, grader, front end loader, sealers, router, chain saw, jackhammer, tamper and more
- Working knowledge to perform minor vehicle & equipment maintenance
- Ability to perform manual labor and frequently lift/move up to 50#s and 100# with assistance
- Must be willing to be on 24 hour call & report within 30 minutes of the call
