



WHEN TO CALL 9-1-1

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE IS NOT AVAILABLE THROUGH THIS WEBSITE

In an emergency call 9-1-1 immediately from any wired or wireless phone.

An emergency is a situation that requires IMMEDIATE assistance from the Police, Fire Department or Emergency Medical Services.

Some examples include:

- Fire
- A crime in progress
- A car crash, especially if there are injuries
- A medical situation such as unconsciousness, difficult breathing, an allergic reaction, chest pain, bleeding, or any other symptoms that require IMMEDIATE medical attention.

If you are not sure if you should call 9-1-1, it is recommended calling and letting the 9-1-1 Call Taker determine whether you need emergency help.
