

ORDINANCE #5

Adopted at a Regular Meeting of the Lackawanna County Commissioners held on July 26, 1977.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Lackawanna and the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Luzerne did by Resolutions dated August 21, 1976 and September 1, 1976, respectively, authorize the filing of an application to the Governor's Justice Commission of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, which acquired funding for the planning of a Bi-County Jail System aimed at improving the effectiveness of the participating counties correctional services; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Lackawanna desires once again to enter into intergovernmental cooperation agreement to continue the above mentioned study with the County of Luzerne through a new continuation subgrant from the Governor's Justice Commission of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania;


BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained, that the County of Lackawanna be, and is hereby authorized, to enter into intergovernmental cooperation agreement with the County of Luzerne as specified below:

- 1. This agreement shall be contingent upon approval by the Governor's Justice Commission of a new continuation grant.
- 2. This agreement shall be in full force and effect upon the awarding of a continuation subgrant by the Governor's Justice Commission and continue until the conclusion of the work activities comprehended by the subject application.
- 3. The purpose of this agreement is to authorize the continuation of plans and recommendations geared toward the improvement of the joint counties Correctional Systems within the Bi-County area of Lackawanna and Luzerne Counties.
- 4. The County of Lackawanna does hereby authorize the expenditure of Two Thousand, Four Hundred, Sixty-two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2,462.50) as its share of carrying out the program specified in the subject application. The said Two Thousand, Four Hundred Sixty-two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2,462.50) appropriation shall be drawn from the County's General Fund. It is the sense of this paragraph to provide five (5%) per cent of the total cost of undertaking the work activities described in the above-mentioned application to the Governor's Justice Commission or such lesser amount as may be required in the event that the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania makes a financial buy-in contribution towards this undertaking.
- 5. Should any property, real or personal, be acquired in the process of this undertaking, such property shall be held in joint ownership by the Counties of Lackawanna and Luzerne.


