AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF LACKAWANNA AND THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 1998 AND APPROPRIATE SPECIFIC SUMS ESTIMATED TO BE REQUIRED FOR THE SPECIFIC PURPOSES OF THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT, HEREINAFTER SET FORTH DURING THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Lackawanna Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property within the said County subject to taxation for County purposes for the fiscal year 1998 as follows: Tax rate for general County purposes,

the sum of 19.9693 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation

or the sum of 199.693 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation


for debt purposes, the sum of 4.16 mills on each dollar assessed valuation or the sum of 41.60 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation

for purposes of the County Library System, the sum of 1.6 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation

or the sum of 16.00 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation

Total millage for all purposes is the sum of 25.7293 mills


