**AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF STAUFFER INDUSTRIAL
PARK ROAD AS A NO PARKING ZONE IN THE BOROUGH OF TAYLOR,
LACKAWANNA COUNTY**

WHEREAS, Lackawanna County is a Third Class County existing pursuant to the Laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the County of Lackawanna adopted, owns and maintains that certain roadway known and designated as Stauffer Industrial Park Road in the Borough of Taylor, Lackawanna County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Lackawanna has the right to regulate traffic on all County roadways pursuant to §§2702 and 2705 Of the Pennsylvania County Code; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has conducted a traffic evaluation of Stauffer Industrial Park Road and has recommended that it would be in the best interests and for the public safety that certain sections of this roadway be designated a No Parking Zone.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Lackawanna County, as follows:

1. The southerly side of Stauffer Industrial Park Road, in the Borough of Taylor, Lackawanna County, between it's intersection with Continental Street and it's intersection with the Canadian Pacific Railroad crossing, is hereby designated as a No Parking Zone.
2. The Department of Roads and Bridges is hereby directed to post No Parking signs along the southerly side of Stauffer Industrial Park Road, in the Borough of Taylor, Lackawanna County, between it's intersection with Continental Street and it's intersection with the Canadian Pacific Railroad crossing, as set forth herein, to conform with all applicable statutes and regulations.
3. Any violator of said posted No Parking Sign shall be subject to fine and penalties imposed pursuant to the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, Title 75§ 3353(e).
4. If a section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction; such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after publication as required by law.

ADOPTED at a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Lackawanna County held on October 9, 2013.
