

FIRST READING: December 8, 1983

ADOPTED: December 14, 1983

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF LACKAWANNA and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fixing the tax rate for the year 1984 and appropriate specific sums estimated to be required for the specific purposes of the County government, hereinafter set forth during the current fiscal year and the specific amounts contained therein for the year 1984 Capital Budget.

BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby resolved and enacted by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Lackawanna, Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property within the said County subject to taxation for County purposes for the fiscal year 1984 as follows: Tax rate for general County purposes,

the sum of twenty four and 6.25 one-hundredths (24.0625) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation

or the sum of two hundred and forty and 6.25 tenths (240.625) cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation

for debt purposes, the sum of three and one half (3.5) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation or the sum of thirty five (35) cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation

for purposes of the County Library System, the sum of two and fifty hundredths (2.5) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation

or the sum of twenty-five (25) cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation

Total millage for all purposes is the sum of thirty and 6.25 hundredths (30.0625) mills to become effective ten days after final adoption.
