

ORDINANCE #31

FIRST READING: January 22, 1985

ADOPTED: February 12, 1985

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF LACKAWANNA, PENNSYLVANIA under the Home Rule Charter of Lackawanna County effective January 1, 1986. the Tax Assessment Predetermined Ratio be and is hereby amended from thirty-five percent (35%) of the Market Value of Real Estate as reflected by our present Real Estate Tax Roll to one hundred per cent (100%) of the same, and that the millage on Real Estate Taxes be correspondingly reduced from 28.94065 of the Assessed Value to 10,129219.

WHEREAS, the Lackawanna County Home Rule Charter commands that a change in assessment ratio be made by Ordinance;

The Commissioners of Lackawanna County do ordain the changes above written, repealing obsolete and inconsistent ordinance and providing an effective date of ten (10) days after the date of adoption of this Ordinance.

ADOPTED at a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners held on February 12, 1985.
