
First Reading - December 16, 1986 Second Reading - December 28, 1986
 AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF LACKAWANNA PENNSYLVANIA under the Home Rule Charter of Lackawanna County fixing the tax rate for the year 1987 and appropriate specific sums estimated to be required for the specific purposes of the County Government, hereinafter set forth during the current fiscal year.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Lackawanna Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1: That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property with the said County subject to taxation for County purposes for the fiscal year 1987 as follows: Tax rate for general County purposes, the sum of 9.3493 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of 93.493 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation, for debt purposes, the sum of .780 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation or the sum of 7.80 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation. For purposes of the County Library System, the sum of .875 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation, or the sum of 8.75 cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation; for Personal Property purposes the sum of four (4.0) mills on each dollar of the assessed valuation, or the sum of forty (40) cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation.


Total millage for all purposes is the sum of 15.0043 mills to become effective ten (10) days after final adoption.
