
Stay At Home Order



COVID-19 Situation Update

- As of [April 21](#), the Montgomery County CBTS has tested **1,313 (+135)** people at the Montgomery County Community College since testing began at the site on April 15.
- As of [April 21](#), the Mohegan Sun Arena CBTS (Northeast PA) has tested **127 (+78)** people since testing began at the site on April 20.
- As of April 21, the Temple Liacouras Center Alternate Care Site in Philadelphia has **3** patients.
- DHS announced a study to assess the impact of COVID-19 on PA child care providers.
- DOH announced on April 21 that they are now including probable cases in both statewide case and death totals.
- The US Navy Blue Angels and the US Air Force Thunderbirds will be doing a fly over of Center City Philadelphia today in a “display of national unity.”
- There are three long-term care facilities scheduled for a site visit today to determine possible staffing needs:
 - Gracedale LTC Facility (Northampton)
 - Pleasant Valley Manor LTC Facility (Monroe)
 - Jewish Home of Eastern PA LTC Facility (Lackawanna)


