

How to file to Modify a Custody Order:

-The Family Court Administrator's Office is currently **closed to the public**. All petitions for custody are to be completed and heard **remotely**.

-You can find custody petitions and related forms on the Lackawanna County website at **www.lackawannacounty.org** under Government Directory, then click Judiciary, then Family Court. The forms may also be found under the tab "Document Shop."

-To modify a current custody order, you must file a Custody Petition and Criminal Record - Abuse History Verification.

-The forms must be filled out **completely**, otherwise delay in processing will occur. Be sure to include your court docket number on your petition, if applicable.

-The filing fee to modify a custody order is \$35.00, made payable to Lackawanna County Clerk of Judicial Records, in the form of check or money order. When your paperwork is complete, please place it in the Clerk of Judicial Records box for processing.

-If you are indigent and unable to pay the filing fee, you may complete the In Forma Pauperus Petition to ask the Court to waive the fee. This form can be found on the website under "Family Court."
