

**NOTICE OF SECOND PUBLIC HEARING
LACKAWANNA COUNTY, PA
FOR THE FY 2020 CDBG PROGRAM**

Notice is hereby given by Lackawanna County that a Second Public Hearing will be held on Tuesday December 15, 2020 at 10:00 a.m., prevailing time.

The purpose of the Second Public Hearing is to obtain citizen comments on the proposed use of the FY 2020 CDBG funds by Lackawanna County for its non-entitlement and entitlement municipalities. The County will receive an allocation of \$1,589,542.00 in FY 2020 CDBG funds from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED).

A copy of the County's proposed FY 2020 CDBG Application will be available for public review on the Lackawanna County Community Development's website on Thursday December 10, 2020. The County will accept comments on the proposed use of CDBG funds and its budget for FY 2020 until 4:00 p.m., December 14, 2020. The Board of Commissioners of Lackawanna County will meet virtually on December 16, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. to consider the applications.

The County proposes to use its FY 2020 CDBG Program funds for the following activities:

Lackawanna County encourages participation of low to moderate income persons.

This notice also serves to inform Lackawanna County residents that the County has adopted an Anti-Displacement/Relocation Assistance Policy which would be used should any of its activities result in the displacement, or relocation, of any families due to activities undertaken with CDBG funds. The County does not anticipate undertaking any activities with FY 2020 CDBG funds that will result in permanent displacement. In addition, the County has adopted a Fair Housing Resolution. The County has prepared a Fair Housing Plan which is on file at the Department of Planning and Economic Development and can be reviewed during normal working hours at the Department of Planning and Economic Development Offices.

All interested citizens are encouraged to attend the Public Hearing and will be offered the opportunity to present written comments concerning the proposed FY 2020 CDBG Program activities and prior year programs.
