

Public Hearing Notice

Lackawanna County will hold a Public Hearing to discuss proposed modifications for Lackawanna County on behalf of the following municipalities: Archbald, Blakely Dunmore, Jessup, and Taylor Boroughs for the Federal Fiscal Years 2016 and 2017 Community Development Block Grant Program;

For the Federal Fiscal Year 2016 - the modification will delete the Clearance and Demo line item for the Archbald Borough Clearance and Demo Project. It will transfer the remaining funds (\$40,000.00) to the Water/Sewer Improvement line item for the Archbald Borough 1st Street Water/Sewer Box Culvert Replacement Project;

For the Federal Fiscal Year 2016 – the modification will transfer (\$23,260.61) from the Dunmore Borough Housing Rehab (Single Unit Residential) line item to create the Street Improvement line item for the Dunmore Borough Chestnut Street and Sidewalk Pavement Improvement Project;

For the Federal Fiscal Year 2016 – the modification will transfer the remaining funds (\$46,003.35) from the completed Water/Sewer Improvement line item for the Jessup Borough Delaware and Hand Street Sanitary and Storm Sewer Project. The transferred funds will create the Public Facilities/Other line item for the Jessup Borough Memorial Park ADA Restrooms Project;

For the Federal Fiscal Year 2017 – the modification will transfer (\$30,968.66) from the Housing Rehab (Single Unit Residential) line item to create the line item Street Improvements for the Blakely Mott Haven Section Block 3 Street Improvements Project;

For the Federal Fiscal Year 2017 – the modification will transfer (\$25,302.54) from the completed Water/Sewer Improvement line item for the Taylor Borough Jefferson Street Storm Sewer Project – Phase 2 to the Public Facilities/Other line item for the Taylor Borough Buiding ADA Vestibule Door Project.

In order to comply with the Board’s Declaration of Disaster Emergency dated March 16, 2020, and Governor Wolf’s Shelter in Place Order dated March 27, 2020, the meeting will be live streamed at [YouTube](#). The public is invited to view this live streamed meeting.

The Public Zoom Hearing for the Modifications will be held at 9:00 A.M., Tuesday, February 2, 2021 and live streamed on YouTube at ECTV.

Lackawanna County encourages participation of low to moderate income persons.

This notice also serves to inform Lackawanna County residents that the County has adopted an Anti-Displacement/Relocation Assistance Policy which would be used should any of its activities result in the displacement, or relocation, of any families due to

activities undertaken with CDBG funds. The County does not anticipate undertaking any activities with CDBG funds that will result in permanent displacement. In addition, the County has adopted a Fair Housing Resolution. The County has prepared a Fair Housing Plan which is on file at the Department of Planning and Economic Development and can be reviewed during normal working hours at the Department of Planning and Economic Development Offices.

All interested citizens are encouraged to attend the Public Hearing and will be offered the opportunity to present written comments concerning the proposed CDBG Program activities.
