COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This Program, developed by the Lackawanna College Police Academy, is being offered to all Lackawanna County Law Enforcement Agencies and is sponsored by Lackawanna County. The Program is four and a half hours in length and is an awareness-level training concerning current topics facing Criminal Justice professionals. The training will cover six areas:

1. Behavioral Health and Substance Abuse
2. De-Escalation
3. Individuals With Special Needs and Mental Health
4. Human Perceptions and How They Affect Behavior and Communication
5. Bias, Profiling and Procedural Justice
6. Sensitivity, Diversity and Inclusion

Participants will receive a Law Enforcement Continuing Education (CLEE) Certification of completion from the Lackawanna College Police Academy. The Pennsylvania Municipal Police Training Commission is authorizing the awarding of 4.5 CLEE credit hours to Pennsylvania Municipal Police Officers to fulfill their mandatory annual training requirement.
